- 4. The Friends will sign the updated RV Storage lease.
- 5. The Friends' Mission Statement will remain unchanged.
- 6. The Friends' meeting schedule has been changed from quarterly to annual. Board members may meet throughout the year as needed.
- 7. The committee discussed the current state of the Friends organization and the possible need to dissolve FNPPL nonprofit.
 - a. The consensus was that North Plains residents need to be made aware of the value added by the Friends over the years and the impact to the library and community if the non-profit organization dissolves.
